Washcloth knitting pattern by Julia Marquardt

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Imprint

You will need <u>cotton yarn</u> you like, matching <u>knitting needles</u>, a <u>tapestry needle</u> and a matchingcrochet hook (optional).

Cast on 40 stitches – small washcloth.

More stitches – more width.

Knitting the stockinette stitch: alternate between 1 row knit stitch, 1 row purl stitch

Optional: Take off the first stitch (beautiful edging)

Colour change:

Add the new colour (tie a knot).

Knit the next 2 rows using the new colur.

Switch again to the old colour.

Switch the colour after 2 rows.

For bigger stripes:

After adding the new colour, make a knot and cut the old colour strand. Sew the ends later.

Knit so many rows until you reach your desired length.

Cast off.

Optional: Use the crochet hook for an elastic cast off.

The knit side up: sew your washcloth using the tapestry needle.

Sew all the ends.

Turn your work inside out.

Purl side is facing you – better for washing.

You're done!

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
