Abbreviations:

cs = chain stitch

sc = single crochet

You will need [smc select Cabaré \(4 balls for adults\)](#) a matching [crochet hook \(10mm\)](#) and a [tapestry needle](#).

Yarn store Switzerland: <http://woolpedia.net>

Start with a usual slipknot and chain 26 stitches.

Row 1: sc

Row 2: 1 cs, 2 sc, 9 cs, 3 sc, 9 cs, 2 sc

Row 3: sc

Row 4: sc

Repeat: row 2 till 4

When your scarf is long enough, cut the yarn, pull it through the last stitch, tighten.
Sew all ends.

Plait

You can do the plait on both sites or only on one of them.

Take the first rib/strand and twist it with your finger. You should get a loop.
Go through the loop with your fingers and grab the next rib, pull it through the loop.
Grab the next rib and pull it through.
Continue this way until the end of the scarf.

You can leave the last loop open. In this case you can change the plait at any time.
You can also sew the last loop to secure it.

Block your work (optional)

Take a bowl and cold water. Dip your work under the water, it should be really wet.
Put it on a towel (even), shape it and let it dry.

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
