

Button crochet pattern

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This tutorial requires basic crochet skills.

Video pattern for beginner:

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet

inc = increase

dec = decrease

st = stitch

You will need [crochet rings](#), [yarn](#), a [matching crochet hook](#) and a [tapestry needle](#).

Start with a magic ring.

Crochet 9sc into the ring.

We work in spiral round and only sc.

1st round: 1 inc every st

2nd round: 1 inc every 2nd st

3rd round: 1 inc every 3rd st

Continue this way until your circle is as big as your crochet ring.

Crochet 1 round sc without inc.

Now put the crochet ring into your crochet work and crochet over it.

The decrease rounds are inversely proportional to the increase rounds.

If your last inc round was the 3rd one, start to dec every 3rd st.

If your last inc round was the 4th one, start to dec every 4th st.

Example for decreasing

1st round: 1 dec every 3rd st

2nd round: 1 dec every 2nd st

3rd round: 1 dec every st

Now cut the yarn, leave enough for sewing on e.g. fabric.

Tie a knot.
